

Notice of Airport Improvement Fee (AIF) Rate Change

Regina Airport Authority (RAA) is a not-for-profit organization that receives no government funding to manage, maintain and develop the Regina International Airport (YQR). As the Airport continues to grow, there is increasing pressure on the airport terminal building and surrounding infrastructure.

The Authority collects an Airport Improvement Fee (AIF) for every enplaned passenger at Regina International Airport, which is used strictly for facility and infrastructure improvements. Capital improvement plans require an AIF increase from \$15 to \$20 to meet increased traffic, facility, and financial demands.

AIF Increase Effective January 1, 2012:

- \$20 AIF per enplaned passenger for all commercial flights
- \$5 AIF (no change) for flights between Regina International Airport (YQR) and Saskatoon's John G. Diefenbaker Airport (YXE)
- Change in effect for all tickets purchased for travel after January 1, 2012 and sold after December 1, 2011
