

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR - SEASONAL

Regina Airport Authority requires an Equipment Operator is responsible for operating heavy and light duty equipment to ensure the Regina International Airport (YQR) is operating in a safe, secure, and efficient manner. The position is accountable for inspecting and maintaining airside and groundside surfaces, general repairs and preventative maintenance work on all surfaces and equipment. The incumbent will perform runway friction measurements, complete surface conditioning reporting and bird and wildlife control and removal. The position is accountable for assisting in emergency situations to ensure YQR is always safe and secure.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- While promoting safety awareness, perform all duties with an ownership attitude in compliance with corporate policies and procedures.
- Assist with ensuring appropriate response procedures are carried out in the event of an emergency.
- Perform all duties and responsibilities in a manner consistent with the companies Mission, Vision and Corporate Values.
- Maintain and repair all airport surfaces, including asphalt, concrete, gravel, grassed and landscaped areas using various types of heavy equipment.
- Conduct airport winter operations duties inclusive of ice and snow removal, application of sand and de-icing chemicals, and inspection and reporting on airside movement surface conditions.
- Remove and control foreign object debris (FOD) and other obstacles on the airfield
- Fulfill duties of Airport Wildlife Control Officer including wildlife control and removal.
- Inspect and evaluate condition of runways, taxiways, and aprons.
- Maintain airport surface and storm water drainage systems.
- General airside and groundside maintenance including waste collection.
- Maintaining perimeter fences, road safety equipment (signs, barriers, and other traffic control devices, etc.).
- Assist with equipment maintenance, special events and projects.
- Understand and comply with all Corporate Policies and Procedures.

REQUIREMENTS

- High school diploma or GED equivalent. Some post-secondary education would be an asset.
- Two (2) years related experience.
- Equivalent combination of education and experience would be considered.
- Knowledge and ability to safely operate various types of heavy equipment, power tools and hand tools.
- Strong communication, organizational and interpersonal skills to professionally manage a multitude of tasks in a customer focused environment.
- Ability to grow and maintain positive professional relationships with corporate departments, key business partners and team members.
- Capable of performing within a transparent work environment where collaborative relationships are encouraged, and varied opinions are respected.
