15 Wing to conduct night training this weekend in Regina

March 12, 2026 – Moose Jaw, Sask. – National Defence/Canadian Armed Forces

15 Wing will be conducting night flying training in the vicinity of Regina, on Friday, March 13, and Saturday March 14, between 8 p.m. and 11h15 p.m.

Flights will be conducted by 2 Canadian Forces Flying Training School near Regina International Airport, with three CT-156 Harvard II, an advanced -turboprop training aircraft. Night flying is an essential component for military pilot training, and its helps student pilots to develop their flying proficiencies. 15 Wing endeavours to be respectful and mindful of communities and will take measures to minimize the potential noise impact.

All RCAF aircraft flying operations are carefully planned and closely controlled for public safety and are dependent on weather and flying conditions.
