

Two new flights to Toronto and Edmonton

The Regina International Airport (YQR) welcomes the addition of two additional flights for Toronto and Edmonton.

Beginning June 2, Monday to Saturday until August 1, 2015, Air Canada will offer a “red eye” flight to Toronto (YYZ) departing Regina (YQR) at 1:45 am. This early flight will allow passengers to meet the many international connections available from the Toronto hub. In addition, WestJet will be offering a daily morning flight to Edmonton (YEG) starting on June 5, 2015 with a departure time of 6:35 am.

“Both of these flights support the demand and growing number of Regina and southern Saskatchewan business and leisure travelers,” said Richmond Graham, President and CEO, Regina Airport Authority. “We are delighted to have additional options to better serve our passenger's needs.”
